



Support School Success

1. Focus on efforts, progress and process – not outcomes, grades or talent
2. Invite child to identify goals and assess progress
3. Base expectations on child's age and abilities – clear about expectations
4. Plan homework routines with child
5. Resign as “Homework Police” – child “owns” homework
6. Partner with child and teacher to address chronic concerns
7. Respectful about teacher and school
8. Refrain from perfectionism
9. Model enthusiastic lifelong learning, acknowledge *mistakes and failure as normal*
10. Provide opportunities for learning outside of school
