6 Principles of the IDEA

- 1. Free and Appropriate Public Education in the Least Restrictive Environment (FAPE)
- 2. Appropriate Evaluation
- **3.** Individualized Education Program
 - Identified in one of the 13 (14) federal disability categories
 - Requires specialized instruction to access education
- 4. Least Restrictive Environment (LRE)
 - Start with a conversation about what supports and services your child needs to access general education curriculum
 - Children should not have to earn their way into general education much evidence that inclusive environments benefit both child with disability and peers
- 5. Parent Participation
- **6.** Procedural Safeguards
 - Offered in writing
 - Explained if you request
