- Approach conversation from problem solving perspective with common goal of helping child
- Make appointment to speak with building administrator to share concerns and provide documentation
- Is there a specialist (counselor, math/reading consultant, etc.) who can provide input?
- Take notes and follow up with respectful emails in conversations and problem solving with teacher/specialists
- If possible/appropriate, request a meeting with parents, teacher and administrator to create an effective plan acceptable to everyone
